Residential Ministries

Providence Shelter – 76 beds (32 women, 44 men); 90 day stay with goals focused on successful exit (housing, income, etc.)

Family Emergency Shelter – 35-50 Women and Children; 90 day stay with goals focused on successful exit (housing, income, etc.)

Residential Program – approx. 100 (men, women, & children); 12-18 month stay with individualized goal plan focused on addressing root issues that contribute to homelessness.

Bridge Program and Intentional Communities – providing next step support before moving out to full independence
